



RENEWAL YEAR SCORE CARD

Six places a renewal date hides. Check one, mark it off, take the ticket. Write every date you find into the month it lands in, so the whole year is on one page and the annual ones stop arriving as a surprise.

1	YOUR PHONE iPhone: Settings, your name, Subscriptions. Android: Play Store, profile, Payments & subscriptions.	☐	☐
2	YOUR REGISTRAR Domain list. Check the expiry column and whether auto-renew is on.	☐	☐
3	YOUR INBOX Search "renews", "renewal" and "receipt". This is where the yearly software lives.	☐	☐
4	YOUR CARDS Annual fees, memberships, anything that charges once and goes quiet.	☐	☐
5	YOUR WALLET Driver's license, car registration, insurance card. The date is printed on it.	☐	☐
6	YOUR DRAWER Passport, warranties, anything filed somewhere safe and then forgotten.	☐	☐

YOUR RENEWAL YEAR

Write what lands in each month, and the cost if it charges you. **Give yourself a reminder a month early**, not the week of, so there's still time to cancel.

ANNUAL CHARGES YOU CAN STILL STOP BEFORE THEY HIT

PLACES CHECKED _____ / 6

One ticket per place you check, not per renewal you find. Six places means six tickets for finishing the sweep. A place with nothing in it still counts, because you checked it.

ANNUAL IS THE ONE THAT GETS YOU
A monthly charge shows up on every statement, so you notice it eventually. A yearly one is invisible for eleven months and then it's already taken the money.

A LIST IS NOT A REMINDER
The page only works if a date comes and finds you. Put each one in whatever already pings you, and set it a month out so you can still cancel.
